PUBLIC SCOPING MEETING FOR AGRICULTURAL ORDER 4.0
AUGUST 2017

The scoping meeting is a listening session where growers and other interested parties have an opportunity to provide comment on the structure and requirements of the Agricultural Order. Staff will not speculate on what future requirements might or might not be at this meeting. The discussion will proceed as follows:

1. Background
Water Board staff will provide a brief presentation summarizing current requirements.
2. Structure of the current Agricultural Order
Attendees of the meeting will have an opportunity to provide comment on the current Ag Order structure, including enrollment; tiering; electronic notice of intent form; annual compliance form.
3. Water Quality Monitoring
Attendees of the meeting will have an opportunity to provide comment on the surface water and groundwater monitoring requirements; cooperatives conducting monitoring such as the Preservation Inc.'s Cooperative Monitoring Program and the Central Coast Groundwater Coalition.
4. Total Nitrogen Applied
Attendees of the meeting will have an opportunity to provide comment on the total nitrogen applied requirement.
5. Tier 3 Ranch Requirements
Attendees of the meeting will have an opportunity to provide comment on Ag Order requirements for tier 3 ranches, including individual surface water discharge monitoring; irrigation and nutrient management plan reporting; water quality buffer plans.
6. Missing Requirements
Attendees of the meeting will have an opportunity to provide comment on the requirements they deem are necessary but currently not in the Ag Order.

A quorum of Central Coast Water Board members may be present; however, the Central Coast Water Board will not be taking any action at the scoping meeting.

The meeting will be conducted in English, Spanish translation will be provided for attendees sharing a comment in Spanish.
